

Scientific Program


The BPN 2022 conference will include a keynote address (Keynote speaker to be announced) and a scientific programme consisting of oral presentations organised into multiple sessions as well as a poster session.

The conference organising committee welcomes presentations that cover the broad range of bioprocessing applications and technologies that are current and emerging and of interest to the sector. This year's conference focal areas will include:

- COVID vaccine developments (new approaches, process development and production, workforce development, etc.)
- Applications for RNA (new targets, process development, production methods and manufacturing, etc.)
- Cell & gene therapies (production challenges, emerging technologies, new targets, etc.)
- Bioprocessing challenges for emerging therapies (including: bacteriophage, extracellular vesicles, new monoclonal antibodies, manufacturing challenges, etc.)
- New technologies (process analytical tools, digital modelling, synthetic biology, etc.)
- Industrial products and foods by precision fermentation (food products, cultured meats, algal production systems, etc.)

Two student awards will be available, one for the best presentation (oral or poster) and one for the best poster presentation.

(Please indicated whether oral or poster presentation is preferred.) All presenting authors **must register** for the conference.

Abstracts must be submitted as a **WORD FILE** and no more than **ONE PAGE**

Please remember to include all of the following:

- Presentation title
- All author(s) full names and their affiliation(s) and the full address of the presenting author.
- Please submit in **12 point Calibri font** with the title in **bold** and the presenting author clearly indicated.
- Abstracts **must be submitted as a Word file.**

Last day for submission of abstracts to be considered for oral presentation is **3 October 2022**. The organising committee and session chairs will review all abstracts and decide which abstracts will be included in the conference oral program.

Trade Exhibition

There will be booths offered for exhibitors on a first come, first booked basis so please plan to secure your booth early, space is strictly limited.
